

## LIQUIDATION

- The Russian Government recognized Batani Foundation as a foreign agent due to its advocacy and support for indigenous rights.
- The Moscow City Court, acting on the demand of the Russian Ministry of Justice, ordered the liquidation of the Batani Foundation.
- Several Batani staff members were exiled from Russia





• Consult indigenous peoples in negotiations with authorities and the private sector on ongoing or planned commercial projects on traditional lands.






